As a newly established and growing independent special school for students on the Autistic Spectrum aged 7-16, we are looking for an enthusiastic Maths Curriculum Manager who is seeking a new and exciting challenge. You will join a growing team with opportunities to influence the development of the school as it continues to expand. You will have a strong knowledge of the Maths curriculum, experience of working up to secondary level and at least 2 years experience of working with children with Autism would be desirable. You will enjoy the challenge of working in a flexible and creative way in a role where you will need to think on your feet. You will ensure delivery of high standards of teaching, learning and assessment and be willing to support and challenge staff enabling pupils to achieve positive outcomes both academically and personally. The role may also involve development and delivery of wider curriculum activities.

You will need to deal with challenging student behaviour and supporting the school ethos in this respect, this will usually involve a different approach to that of a mainstream school. You will need to be able to deal with these situations calmly and effectively and a genuine enthusiasm for working with pupils with ASD/ADHD is critical to the role.

You will also be able to demonstrate you are a self-motivated team player and a leader.

The post you are applying for is defined under Safeguarding Vulnerable Groups Act 2006 (including amendments made under section 64 of the Protection of Freedoms Act 2012) as requiring a criminal records check. This means the successful candidate will be required to apply to the Disclosure and Barring Service for an enhanced check and provide us with the evidence.
